Macon (GA) – The Department of Human Services (DHS) through Macon-Bibb County Economic Opportunity Council (EOC), Inc. will begin providing HEATING assistance for low-income Bibb County residents through the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

Applicants must provide a copy of their most recent energy bill or a statement of services from their utility provider, proof of household income for the last 30 days (such as pay stubs or letter from an employer), a valid Georgia Driver's License or Georgia State Issued I.D. and a Social Security Card or printout for all household members. Life-Threatening Crisis applicants must provide a life-threatening medical statement.

Macon-Bibb County EOC in concert with our mission to "help people and to change lives" is integrating a new call system to make it more convenient for our clients. We listen to the feedback and with this new system will help eliminate long lines of waiting for services.

To qualify for the LIHEAP program, applicants must have a yearly household income less than or equal to 60% of the state median income, as defined by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.
