

Macon Bibb County EOCI Head Start / Early Head Start Pre-K program will open Pre-Kindergarten registration for the 2022-2023 school year January 10 – February 1st. Applications for the Georgia Pre-K program will be processed online through the agency's website at www.maconbibbeoc.com. Submission of the application does NOT guarantee the enrollment. Selection is based upon enrollment for Head Start. For more information, please call 478-738-3240.

Students may attend Pre-K at Walter P. Jones, Buck Melton or Jimmie Samuels @ Agnes Barden Head Start / Early Head Start Centers. Transportation is available for Walter P. Jones and Jimmie Samuels @ Agnes Barden Head Start / Early Head Start Centers. Transportation is not available for Buck Melton.

Parents will be notified by email on March 1st and 2nd, if their child has been accepted into the Macon Bibb County EOCI Head Start / Early Head Start Pre-K Program. If a child's name is **NOT selected**, his or her name will be automatically placed on the waiting list for the school to which they applied.

If a child **is selected**, parents will be required to provide registration documents **AND** proof of residence during the on-site registration process. If registration documents are not received during this time frame, the child's Pre-K slot will be forfeited.

Required Registration documents (*all listed documents are required*):

- Proof of age - Child's certified birth certificate,
- Child's Social Security card,
- Immunization - GA form 3231 (*may be turned in as soon as the child turns 4*)
- Ear, Eye, Dental and Nutrition Screening - GA form 3300 (*may be turned in as soon as the child turns 4*)
- Photo ID of parent/guardian
- Medicaid card: PeachCare, WellCare card or private insurance card

Proof of residence:

- Current lease in the guardian's name
- Current Utility Bill listing the residence as the service address (electric, water, gas, cable)
- Property tax statement
- Current vehicle registration
- Homeowner's insurance bill

****If a student's family is living with someone else, parents should provide a notarized statement from the property resident stating where the child's family is residing, plus a copy of the property resident's proof of residency (any items listed above).**
