

## Frequently Asked Questions

1. **Dress Code:** Pre-K students are not required to follow a dress code. Children should attend school in clean, comfortable clothes that will withstand active play and repeated washings. "Dressy" clothes are not appropriate for school.
2. **Backpacks:** Pre-K students are NOT allowed to bring a backpack. For safety reasons, large blankets, book bags and backpacks are not allowed in the classroom. However, the program does allow small blankets which are the length of the child or bath towel to accommodate children during nap time.
3. **Lunch:** All Pre-K, HS/EHS children are served breakfast, lunch, and a snack daily at no cost. These meals must be consumed at the center. No outside meals may be provided at feeding times. The meals provide two-thirds of the child's daily nutritional needs. The meal-time activity is a part of the children's classroom routine.
